



Erwin Lutzer's New Book *We Will Not Be Silenced* Hits Political Nerve

EUGENE, Ore. (April 8, 2021) – It has been impossible to miss Erwin Lutzer's urgent message to conservatives as his new book [*We Will Not Be Silenced: Responding Courageously to Our Culture's Assault on Christianity*](#) has sold more than 135,000 copies since its November 2020 release. He's also been featured consistently on conservative media, reminding those worried about the country's increasing secularism that they are called to be light in a darkening world.

Rallying like-minded people to unity of purpose, Lutzer's message prescribes practical ways to combat the continual assault on religion, exhorting the core virtues of liberty to a public who is responding with fervor, including over 650 five-star reviews for the book on Amazon.

In a recent interview, Lutzer warned, "I realized something about a year or two ago, and that is that the radical left does not believe that America can be fixed. It believes America has to be destroyed and its institutions have to be destroyed, and on the rubble of our Judeo-Christian heritage."

Lutzer, a pastor for more than 50 years, is gaining a new audience who identifies with his clarion call to continue battling and not be shamed into silence. "We have deeply rooted political differences, but if we are believers, we need to emphasize what we agree on and not divide," Lutzer recently said, "Politics is important – very important. But it is not as important as sharing the gospel. Let us gladly carry the cross into the world and consider opposition a badge of honor."

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Dr. Erwin W. Lutzer is pastor emeritus of The Moody Church, where he served as the senior pastor for 36 years. He is an award-winning author of *One Minute After You Die* and *Hitler's Cross*, as well as the featured speaker on three radio programs heard on more than 750 national and international outlets.
