

# Radical Islam, Nuclear Nightmares, and a 2,600-Year-Old Bible Prophecy

In a recent Gallup poll, Americans overwhelmingly named Iran as the single country that poses the greatest threat to world stability. This should come as no surprise—Americans have long felt uneasy about Iranian President Ahmadinejad's stated goals to "wipe Israel off the map" and bring down the "Little Satan" (Israel) and the "Big Satan" (The United States). Now, with Iran's on-going military buildup and long-range missile program proceeding swiftly, people fear that Iran could have both the will and the capacity to carry out these threats. An observer of the times, Rhodes believes Iran *does* pose a threat to

America, and Israel as well. According to Rhodes, the conflict in the Middle East is at a fever pitch, and emerging alliances between nations could lead to the eventual fulfillment of biblical prophecy. He provides a fascinating, yet sobering analysis of current events, revealing vital information about:

- The rise of radical Islam and its threat to the nation of Israel
- Financial and political ties between the group of nations north of Israel
- The polarization of nations supporting extremist Islam and the rest of the world
- Our worldwide dependency on oil
- Globalization and its role in setting the stage for a cataclysmic war

With escalating tensions in Iran and the Middle East, many have wondered if we could be on the heels of the last days. In light of current events, Rhodes discusses circumstances that may be setting the stage for the fulfillment of Ezekiel 38-39, a 2,600-year-old prophecy that speaks of a massive northern military coalition that will one day invade Israel. Combining extensive study of world affairs and Bible prophecy, Rhodes documents the emergence of potentially key alliances between Russia, Iran, and other nations who would like to see Israel destroyed.

Rhodes helps people better understand the nature of current world tensions in general, and the Israeli-Arab conflict in particular. How extensive is the threat from radical Islam?* and *Could the USA really be in danger of nuclear attack?* He also discusses the current worldwide addiction to oil and how possession and control of this resource may motivate some nations to military action. Finally, Rhodes provides several possible answers to a question that has puzzled Americans for generations: Is America involved in the fulfillment of Bible prophecy?

#### Fast Facts on...

#### Iran and Nuclear Weaponry:

The president's National Security Strategy release in 2006 states: "We may face no greater challenge from a single country than from Iran. For almost 20 years, the Iranian regime hid many of its key nuclear efforts from the international community, yet the regime continues to claim that it does not seek to develop nuclear weapons."



- Just prior to his death in 2006, former Secretary of Defense Casper Weinberger warned: "I think they probably already have gone nuclear....I think they have probably equipped themselves to construct some types of nuclear weapons and...I think they could probably do quite a lot of damage right now."
- Yet, more recently, American intelligence agencies have concluded that Iran has ceased its development of nuclear weapons.
- Many wonder what is *really* going on in Iran. One thing is certain. The Bible indicates that the Ezekiel invasion into Israel by the prophesied northern military coalition does not actually involve a nuclear attack against Israel, but rather involves a massive ground army using conventional weapons.

#### **End Times Extremism Among Muslims:**

- At the apocalyptic end of days, mainstream Shiite Muslims envision that a great, armed jihad will result in the subjugation of the entire world to Islam.
- Mainstream Shiites have long believed in the eventual return of the Twelfth Imam (end-times Muslim leader). It is believed that the time of the appearance of the Twelfth Imam can be hastened through apocalyptic chaos and violence—by unleashing an apocalyptic holy war against Christians and Jews.
- In this light, the current-day mission of Mahmoud Ahmadinejad—Iran's president—takes on great significance: "Our revolution's main mission is to pave the way for the reappearance of the Twelfth Imam, the Mahdi." Ahmadinejad informed his cabinet that just a few more years' time would bring about the appearance of the Twelfth Imam.
- Ahmadinejad believes the destruction of Israel is one of the key global developments that will trigger the appearance of the Twelfth Imam. He therefore seeks to "wipe Israel off the map."
- Ahmadinejad claims he was chosen by Allah himself to play a role in ushering in the end of days.
- This end-times Muslim extremism may be setting the stage for the eventual fulfillment of Ezekiel's prophecy of a northern military coalition invading Israel.

Ron Rhodes is a sought-after conference speaker, seminar leader, and author with more than one million books in print. 
