

Do You Have to be Sexy to Get a Guy?

In a groundbreaking study, the American Psychological Association (APA) found that inappropriate clothing and images are being marketed to girls between the ages of 4-10. The study concluded that the sexualization of young girls in our culture negatively affects their cognitive function, physical and mental health, and sexual development. Leslie Ludy challenges these cultural messages that link a woman's value to her sexuality. Although young women are taught they must be sexy in order to receive love, Ludy shows them that the only approval they will ever need can never

come from any man or worldly standard, but from Christ alone.

Ludy draws from her own beautiful love story and shares from close interactions with thousands of girls to give straightforward advice on these questions and more.

Ludy discusses topics such as ...


- **The state of modern masculinity vs. the Christ-built man**

Q: How do I know if I'm ready for a serious relationship?

Until Jesus Christ becomes your first love, you aren't ready for an earthly prince charming. Unless He alone is the obsession of your heart, you'll always be looking to men to meet needs that only He can fill. When we have a Christ-consumed heart, guys no longer dominate thinking, actions, and decisions. Rather, the Lover of our soul captivates us so completely that every guy we meet clearly sees that Jesus is, and always will be, the number one Prince of our heart.

Q: Am I attracted to the right kind of guys?

Put guys to the "Warrior Poet" test. A true Warrior-Poet emerges only when a man makes the decision to *lay down self* and *take up Christ*. Remember, the mark of a Warrior-Poet does not lie in his *perfection*, but in the *direction* of his life. Is he aimed toward the world, or aimed toward Christ? Is he eagerly pursuing more of Christ, or is he preoccupied with himself?

Q: Do I use my feminine power to manipulate guys?


In our sex-obsessed culture, too many young women fall into the trap of seductive femininity. Proverbs 7 describes the ways of a seductive woman:

And behold, a woman comes to meet him, Dressed as a harlot and cunning of heart. She is boisterous and rebellious, her feet do not remain at home; She is now in the streets, now in the squares, and lurks by every corner. So she seizes him and kisses him and with a brazen face she (speaks) to him... (Proverbs 7:10-13 NASB)

This woman is physically aggressive toward guys, sensually dressed, always "on the prowl" for men. She uses strategic flirting and manipulation to lure guys into her seductive power. Do you fit any of those descriptions? If so, you are using your feminine allure to manipulate the opposite sex.

Q: Are my standards too high?

Too many young women lower their standards out of desperation. But if you settle for less than a man who is fully yielded and surrendered to the King of all kings, you settle for less than God's best for you. You may not feel worthy of a noble, gallant, Christ-built Warrior-Poet who will lay down his life for you. But this is exactly what Christ is to you. And this is exactly what He desires for you in an earthly prince.
