As a worship leader, she leads others into the presence of God through music that illuminates Jesus Christ. Her ability to take a room full of people and unite their souls in an unforgettable worship experience goes far beyond her soulful voice and engaging personality.

Smith was a contributor to the book *Experiencing God's Power in Your Ministry* by Mary Southerland and is a regular contributor for Girlfriends in God daily e-devotions, sent to 90,000+ women subscribers.

Broken into Beautiful, Smith's first book, is about the God who transforms lives from "worthless into precious, guilty to forgiven, hungry into satisfied, and empty into full." Along with her own powerful story, Smith shares true accounts of Christian women with shattered dreams, shameful secrets, damaged souls, and the God who makes them beautiful again. As the book unfolds, women will be reminded of God's willingness to eternally forgive and forget and of His heart to transform broken lives. *Broken into Beautiful* is ultimately about our beautiful Savior who became broken for us so that we could be transformed into a reflection of His flawless beauty.
